A staff member may file a grievance if he or she believes that he or she:

- (i) has been unfairly treated by the University in regard to the interpretation or application of University policy insofar as it relates to his or her academic career and working conditions; or
- (ii) has been subjected to arbitrary, discriminatory, or unreasonable actions takenhing ainst or her by the University, either by act or omission.

Attempts are to be made to resolve the grievance before it reaches the Committee on Staff Grievances and Disciplinary Procedures, pursuant to the defined Stages 1 afmed Reconfluctions. Following due process, theorem is empowered to form as a firing Committee, hear the matters being grieved, and make recommendations in the spirit of resolution to Public cipal for her consideration.
