SERVICE ANIMAL POLICY FOR RESIDENCES

McGill's Student Accessibility and Achievement (SAA) in consultation with the Office of the Dean of Students is the only one authorized to grant or deny a student's request to bring an animal on campus which includes living in residences, according to McGill's Principles for Animal Accommodation

Student Housing and Hospitality Services (SHHS) have the authority to grant a residence student permission to reside on campus with an animal.

Residence students who are granted accommodation for their service animals in Residence will proceed as per standard application procedures.

- SHHS reserves the right to "assign" the student's residence based on availability and the needs of other residents.
- The animal must not cause any nuisance or inconvenience to other residents (noise, cleanliness, smell, aggression etc.).
